<b>1 Canadian Identity</b> To what extent have individuals, groups, and governments helped shape Canadian Identity?	Is there a Canadian Identity?  What are some significant forces that have helped shape Canadian identity?  How is Canadian identity continuing to evolve?	Explores the history and nature of debate on the issue of Canadian identity.  Examines factors that have influenced Canadian identity such as, demographics, social change, and government policies on immigration, multiculturalism, and Aboriginal peoples.  Analyzes social, political, and economic factors that may shape Canadian identity in the future.
<b>2 Politics and Diversity</b> To what extent has diversity helped shape politics in Canada?	What are some key aspects of diversity in Canada?  How has the constitutional debate reflected diverse voices?  How has regional diversity affected politics?	Explores the influences of regionalism, Aboriginal peoples, immigration, and other forces on diversity in Canada.  Analyzes roles played by various groups in shaping constitutional debate in Canada.  Analyzes political issues of particular importance to Canada's northern, western, central, and Atlantic regions.

<p><b>4 International Security</b></p> <p>To what extent have Canada and Canadians responded to international security issues?</p>	<p>How does Canada participate in international security?</p> <p>How has Canada responded to international events?</p> <p>How was September 11, 2001, a turning point for Canada?</p>	<p>Analyzes the nature and challenges of Canada's involvement in matters of international security.</p> <p>Traces Canada's changing role in international affairs such as the Gulf War, conflicts in the former Yugoslavia, Somalia, and Rwanda, as well as the International Criminal Court.</p> <p>Analyzes the effects of the events of September 11, 2001, on Canada and its relationship with the U.S. and the Middle East.</p>
