
CHAPTER 6 JOB COST

In Chapter 6, PCA's Job Cost system is taught. PCA lets your students assign Job ID codes to purchases, sales, and employee hours. Your students will understand how each of these factors--purchases, sales, and employee hours--impact costs for a specific job.

The flowchart that follows illustrates how this works:


