He also received various awards, including the E. L. Grant Award of the American Society for Quality, Engineer of the Year Award of the Peoria Engineering Council, teaching and professional excellence awards, and the Award of Excellence of the Quality Control and Reliability Engineering Division of the Institute of Industrial Engineers.
