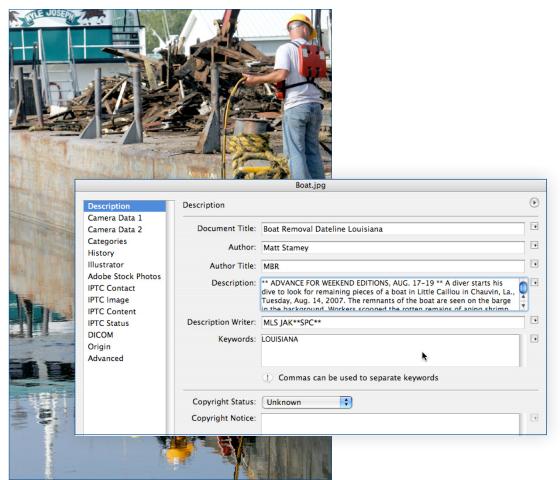
## **5.6 USING FILE INFO**

DIRECTIONS: Back in chapter 1, we learned about writing photo cutlines. Often, the photo credit is designed as part of the cutline. Practice placing a caption using the Link File Info... command in Adobe InDesign. Start by typing a complete caption in the File Info fields of a photo in Adobe Photoshop. Place that photo on the page and select Link File Info... from the Links palette in Adobe InDesign. Copy and paste the caption on the page and apply whatever styles you've created for the caption and the photo credit, ensuring the appropriate amount of space between the photo and the credit line, the credit line and the cutline and the cutline and the text.

**-CREDIT LINE**: Allow 3 points between photos and credit lines.

••• CUTLINE: Allow 3 points between credit lines and cutlines. Allow 3 points between photos and cutlines if there's no credit line.

..... **TEXT**: Allow 1 pica between cutlines and text.
