## **CHAPTER 8 ONLINE EXERCISES**

## **Objective:**

These online activities will introduce you to the use of e-mail search Web sites and online yellow pages.

Click on Online Exercises. You will see a list of Web site links that will bring you to different e-mail search Web sites and online Yellow Pages. Use these Web sites to complete Activity 8.1 and 8.2.

## Activity 8.1

- 1. Select several e-mail search Web sites to visit.
- 2. If you have an e-mail address, search for your e-mail address. If you do not have an e-mail address, search for your telephone number.
- 3. Search for either the e-mail address or telephone number of someone you know.
- 4. On a sheet of paper, compose a fictional e-mail to a friend describing how successful or unsuccessful you were in finding his or her e-mail address or telephone number. You should also discuss the differences you found in the various e-mail search Web sites. Make sure your e-mail projects a "you attitude" and shows a sincere interest in the reader.
- 5. Write your name on your paper and hand it in to your instructor.

## Activity 8.2

- 1. Select one of the online Yellow Pages to visit.
- 2. Choose a business whose address you would like to search. Enter the business's name, city, state, or ZIP Code to locate the business. Follow the instructions to obtain a map to the business. Some online Yellow Pages may require you to click on a Yellow Pages link before entering the address information.
- 3. Print the map of the business.
- 4. On the back of your printout, write a paragraph that provides instructions on obtaining a map through an online Yellow Pages service, or you may write a paragraph about your experience in obtaining the map. Some questions you may want to consider in your paragraph include:
  - a. What information should a person have prior to entering the Web site?
  - b. How difficult was the process of obtaining a map?
  - c. Do you recommend online Yellow Pages or standard Yellow Pages? What are the advantages and disadvantages of each?
- 5. Write your name on the front of the printout and hand it in to your instructor.
