## **Objective:**

## **Activity 18.1**

- 1. Select one of the personality profile Web sites to visit.
- 2. Complete the personality questionnaire offered on the Web site you have chosen. You may have to click on several links within the Web site to answer the personality questionnaire.
- 3. On a sheet of paper, write a paragraph describing whether you think the personality profile is an actual reflection of your personality. You may want to consider the following questions in your paragraph:

  - b. Do you find that the answer choices limit your ability to represent your personality?
  - c. Do you think it is possible to characterize your personality into more than one category?
