**Customer's Concern:** A few days ago I was parking my car and hit the curb pretty hard with the right front wheel. Since then the brakes don't seem to be working right. Now when I apply the brakes, it pulls very hard to the left.

Customer Vehicle: Ford Mustang.

# **Possible Causes of This Challenge:**

1. Bent wheel and rotor.

### **Safety First Practices to Follow:**

- 1. Properly raise vehicle on lift or use a jack and jack stands.
- 2. Use proper manufacturer's instructions to check ball joints.
- **3.** Properly set vehicle up on alignment machine.
- **4.** Use caution when handling tires; embedded nails and glass can cut your hands.

## **Tools and Equipment Required:**

- 1. Vehicle service information.
- **2.** Torque wrench.
- 3. Proper measuring device to check ball joint wear.
- 4. Alignment machine.
- 5. Electronic wheel balance machine (preferably one that can verify radial force variations.)
