ANSWER KEY TO CHALLENGE SHEET

TRANSMISSION SERVICE CHALLENGE

Customer's Concern: My transmission fluid smells like burnt paper and is dark in color. The car shifts fine. I think that servicing the transmission now would help to prevent any troubles in the future.

Customer Vehicle: Subaru Legacy.

Possible Causes of This Challenge:

- 1. Transmission fluid is hygroscopic, meaning it absorbs moisture. This moisture causes fluid to oxidize and change color.
- 2. This vehicle has a high-performance engine that generates a fair amount of heat. This can cause the fluid to smell "burnt."

Safety First Practices to Follow:

- 1. Wear safety glasses at all times.
- **2.** Follow lift operating instructions.
- **3.** Remove all but two pan bolts. Then loosen both bolts several turns. This will allow the transmission to slowly drain and avoids fluid spills.
- 4. Follow all safety rules when using hand tools.

Tools and Equipment Required:

- 1. Hand tools.
- **2.** Lb-in torque wrench.
- **3.** Fluid and filter.
- 4. Pan gasket.
