### **Safety First Practices to Follow:**

- 1. Do not create any sparks when working around gasoline.
- 2. Connect vehicle exhaust system to a vent hose in a closed shop.
- **3.** Watch out for moving or hot parts when making under-hood inspection.
- **4.** Use manufacturer's instructions when using test equipment.

# **Tools and Equipment Required:**

- 1. Vehicle service information and hand tools.
- **2.** Compressor tester.
- 3. Cylinder leakage tester.
- **4.** Engine diagnostic machine or oscilloscope.
- **5.** Hand-held vacuum pump and gauge.
