Customer Vehicle: Ford F-150.

Possible Causes of This Challenge:

- 1. Idle set too high.
- **2.** Timing out of adjustment.
- **3.** Excessive carbon buildup in combustion chamber.
- **4.** Broken motor mount.

Safety First Practices to Follow:

- 1. Do not create any sparks when working around gasoline.
- 2. Connect vehicle exhaust system to a vent hose in a closed shop.
- 3. Watch out for moving or hot parts when making under-hood inspection.
- 4. To prevent electrical shock, do not handle ignition components while engine is running.

Tools and Equipment Required:

- 1. Vehicle service information and hand tools.
- **2.** Flashlight or shop light; timing light.
- **3.** Engine diagnostic machine or oscilloscope.
- 4. Vacuum gauge.
- **5.** Appropriate scanner or test equipment.
