- **4.** Damaged distributor cap or rotor.
- **5.** Defective spark plugs or cables.
- **6.** Excessive retarded ignition timing.

# **Safety First Practices to Follow:**

- 1. Wear safety glasses at all times.
- 2. Connect vehicle's exhaust system to a vent hose in a closed shop.
- 3. Make sure vehicle is in Park or Neutral and parking brake is set.
- 4. To prevent electrical shock, do not handle ignition components while engine is running.
