Possible Causes of This Challenge:

- 1. Leaking hoses, "O" rings, or loose hose connection.
- 2. Leaking power steering pump seal or reservoir.
- 3. Leaking steering gear shaft seal.
- **4.** Leaking pitman shaft seal.
- 5. Leaking steering gear cover seal.

Safety First Practices to Follow:

- 1. Wear safety glasses at all times.
- **2.** Connect vehicle exhaust to a vent hose in a closed shop.
- 3. Make sure vehicle is in Park or Neutral and parking brake is set.
- **4.** Watch out for moving or hot parts when inspecting under the hood.

Tools and Equipment Required:

- 1. Vehicle service information.
- **2.** Flashlight or shop light.
- **3.** Air blow gun.
- **4.** Shop towels.
- 5. Will likely need proper power steering fluid to add to system.
