<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • flow of food: the path food takes from when it is received by an establishment to when it is disposed of as waste • this helps workers spot potential problems and make sure proper procedures are being followed 	<p>HACCP BASICS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • By using a tested system called HACCP, the flow of food can be monitored to spot potential hazards <p>SYSTEM MONITORING</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Foodservice workers are responsible for monitoring the food safety system in place

Cues	Note Taking
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • receiving: accepting delivery of food and supplies • food preparation: cooking and preparing foods to be eaten • disposal point: the point at which food remaining after being eaten is disposed of properly 	<p>RECEIVE AND STORE FOOD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attention needs to be paid at the critical control points in the flow of food, from receiving through serving <p>PREPARATION AND COOKING</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food preparation is a critical point where food could become unsafe <p>DISPOSAL POINT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cleaning and sanitizing are key actions at the disposal point
<p>Summary</p> <p>Foodservice workers need to follow proper guidelines at each critical point of the flow of food, from receiving through serving.</p>
